Project ideas you could choose from:

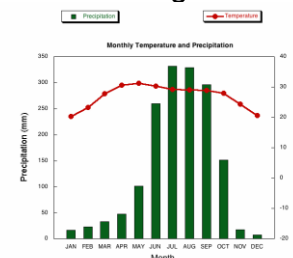
Create a non-chronological report about an endangered rainforest creature. Explain what class (reptile, mammal etc) they belong to and where they are found. Explain how the creature is adapted to live in its rainforest habitat, why it is in danger and how we can help protect it. Include a drawing or photograph.

Create your own 3D rainforest. This could be a junk model, a model in a shoe box, or you could plant and grow your own rainforest.

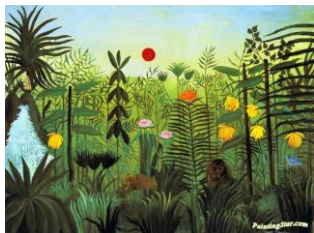


Write a poem about a rainforest. It could be an acrostic poem, a kenning, a cinquain or in any other style you would like.

Record and compare the temperature and rainfall here compared to a rainforest over a week, 2 weeks or a month. Could you record these on a graph and explain your findings?



Complete a piece of artwork. Research a famous artist and see if you can create a piece of work in their style. You can select an artist you like or you could use Rousseau who is a rainforest artist.



Produce an information sheet, booklet, PowerPoint to inform others about the importance of our rainforests and what needs to be done to look after them.

Write a diary in the role of someone exploring the rainforest for the first time. Think about your senses and using descriptive vocabulary to build an image in the readers head.


Create a list of foods and produce that you can buy that comes from the rainforest. Please include what plant or animal the products comes from. Think carefully about how you would record and present this.
