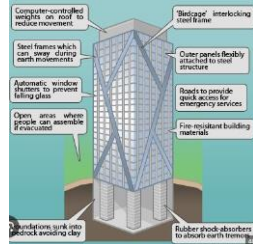

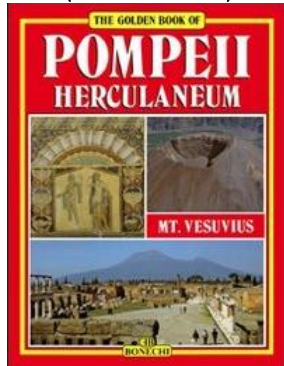
Angry Earth - Summer Term 2023

Research the clothing volcanologists wear at work. Design and label an outfit for a volcanologist. (Art/D&T)	Research some famous facts about volcanoes. Create a 10 questions 'true or false' quiz. Try it out on your family or friends. (English) 	Research Mount Etna or another Volcano and create a factual PowerPoint to present in class. (Humanities)	Create your own pop art picture of a volcano. Research the temperatures of different volcanic countries e.g. Hawaii, Iceland, Italy. Present your findings in a table. (Maths)	Sometimes our emotions can feel like an eruption! Write a list of suggestions to do for someone who may feel angry or upset. (PSHE)	Research the shape and structures of earthquake proof buildings. Design and build an earthquake proof structure.
