Family Factfinder

Speak to relations and find out what stories you have relating to WWII in your family history. Perhaps you can find some photos or artefacts from your family's history.



Let's Get Technical

Use your DT skills to either;

- Make a model air raid shelter
- Design a game themed on WW2 or Europe
- Make do and mend - make a toy using only recycled materials



Express Yourself

- Research and perform a wartime song or dance from the 1940s.
- Write your own song or dance based on our topic.



Country Expert

Use internet research, books and Google Maps to explore the human and physical geographical features of a European country of your choice.

Choose how to present your research (e.g. collage, leaflet, travel agent video). Include information on cities, rivers, mountains, populations, languages, culture.

Travel Guru

Plan a European Travel Adventure! Use the internet, travel guides from home or the library or travel brochures to help. Plan an itinerary which would allow someone to visit key European landmarks.

Include a map and find out how you would travel between locations.



Language Lover

Learn how to speak some words in another European language. Create a way of teaching these to other children e.g. posters, games, quizzes, matching games.



Please choose at least one project from the above, **or discuss your own idea with us.**

You should hand the project in by **Friday 22nd March 2024.** You can do this by returning it to school or by uploading it to Teams.
Children will have time to share their project with the class during the week after the hand in date.

This project is to be completed over the full Spring term, so we do expect a piece of work that is completed to a **high standard.** It is important that you plan this as a family and choose a project that will allow you to enjoy the process.
